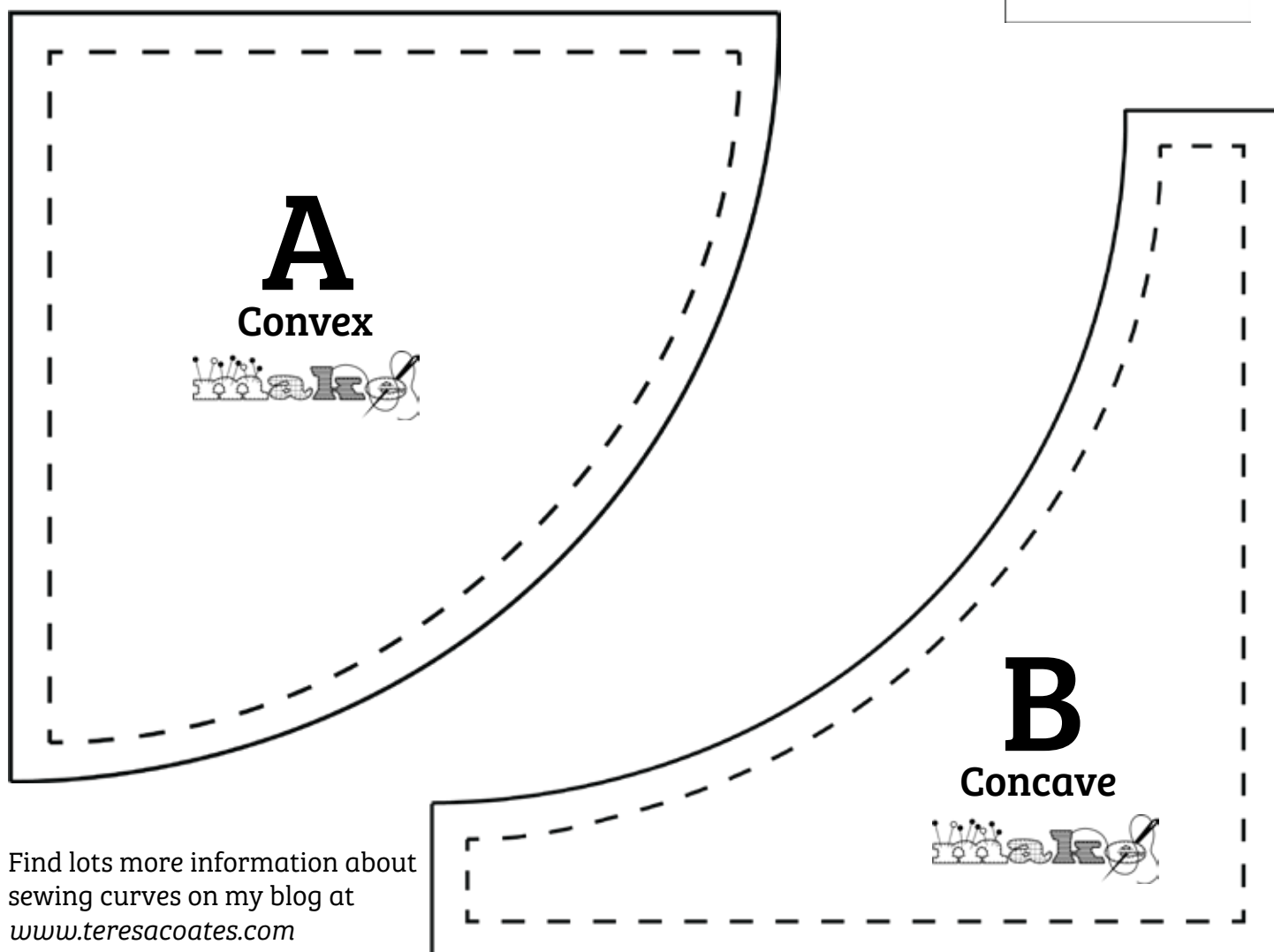
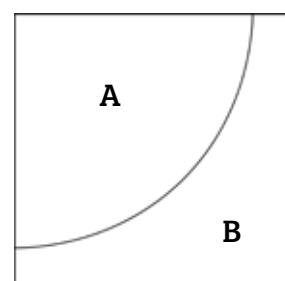

Sew A Drunkard's Path Block

1. Trace template A onto focus fabric. Trace template B on background fabric.
2. Cut along line using a 28mm rotary cutter or micro-serrated scissors.
3. Fold each piece in half and mark centers-- A on right side, B on the wrong side.
4. Lay fabrics right side together with Fabric A on the bottom, matching centers.
3. Pin or glue baste center position.
4. Pin or glue baste ends of curve, right sides together.
5. Pin or glue baste the remainder of the curve, stretching to fit. Clip if needed.
6. Sew with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
7. Press seam allowances.
8. Trim to a $4\frac{3}{4}$ " square.
